Nicholas Mitchell Garcia, a native of Covington, Virginia, is a doctoral student in organ performance at the University of Notre Dame where he studies with Craig Cramer.

Garcia holds the degree master of sacred music from Notre Dame and the degree bachelor of music in organ performance from Westminster Choir College, New Jersey. At Westminster he studied conducting with James Jordan; keyboard harmony with Stefan Young, a former student of the celebrated French pedagogue Nadia Boulanger; and organ with Alan Morrison. As a member of the Westminster Symphonic Choir, Garcia performed Johannes Brahms's *Ein deutsches Requiem* with the Philadelphia Orchestra at Verizon Hall under the direction of Yannick Nézet-Séguin and Gustav Mahler's *Symphony No. 2* with the Berlin Philharmonic at Carnegie Hall under the direction of Simon Rattle.

At Notre Dame, Garcia has worked as a graduate assistant at the Basilica of the Sacred Heart, singing with the Basilica Schola and the Notre Dame Liturgical Choir. He now serves as organist at St. Mark Catholic Church in Niles, Michigan, and at Moreau Seminary at Notre Dame.
